The New Testament Church Prepare for Change #10 – <u>The Meek shall Inherit the Earth</u> August 11, 2024 - Pastor Paul Jehle

I Deuteronomy 29:29 - God is Sovereign - Omniscient, Omnipresent, Omnipotent

- A. We have recently examined what it means to have a "face to face" walk with God
 - 1. It is learning to discern God's ways (character) and not just His acts
 - 2. Numbers 12:3 (Aaron and Miriam's discord), the man Moses was very meek
 - a. The meek (not the famous, proud, controlling) shall inherit the earth Matthew 5:5
 - b. If you want to potentially be around at the end, embrace meekness (Mt. 13:30,43)
 - 1. Meek "bow down, humility" toward God; "gentle, mild" in considering others
 - 2. Confident and bold, yet avoiding *pride* toward God, and *harsh* toward others
- B. What is happening is <u>allowed by God</u> His <u>omniscience</u> of God (hidden things)
 - 1. God allows the **enemy** to attack and works it into His plan Romans 8:28
 - 2. God allows the free will of man to manifest sin, working that into His plan as well
- C. God places *limits* on sin, evil and worldly power Omnipresence (created things)
 - 1. Sinful behavior is allowed to manifest only so far before being exposed -2^{nd} Tim. 3:9
 - 2. The enemy is given permission to attack but only so far Job 1:12ff
- D. In our day, God is preparing to *manifest* His Kingdom Omnipotence (revealed things)
 - 1. His Church is learning that Christ's Kingdom is the focus, not economics or politics
 - 2. "Babylon" symbol of corruption of culture collapse upon itself; timed with...
 - 3. Manifesting His Kingdom "mountain rising" (Da. 2:35) truth applied to every area
 - 4. We will be seeing miraculous interventions of God in the days ahead
 - a. The whole creation is groaning as the Kingdom comes forth Romans 8:19
 - b. God stopping evil's intentions and plans openly and publicly some humbled
 - c. The miraculous timing of events, people and places personally some recognize it
 - d. Prophetic insight by God's Word applied vs. "angels" and miraculous alone
 - e. The "gift of miracles" for healing, guidance, and security His intervention

II 1st Kings 13 – An example of the need for a "humble anointing" – the fruit of self-control A. Lessons from "no-name" people who are heroes ("little maid", wise man of Ecc., etc.)

- 1. Jeroboam and Rehoboam were the first two kings of the divided Israel and Judah
 - a. Rehoboam did not listen to older counsel, made things worse (Judah) harsh
 - b. Jeroboam took Israel (10 tribes) reacted against Jerusalem into idolatry pride
- 2. Prophets in that day were social reformers, speaking the "word of God" to culture
 - a. A no-name prophet comes to Jeroboam from Judah, confronting him at the altar
 - b. He proclaims that Josiah (350 years in advance), would burn priests' bones on it
 - c. Jeroboam wants to arrest him, but gets leprosy, and the altar splits apart as a sign
 - d. Jeroboam asks for, and receives, healing, but is denied giving the prophet a reward
 - e. The sons of an older prophet told him what happened, and he went after him
 - f. He invited him home, told him "an angel told me" so he disobeyed God's word
 - g. In departing, he was killed by a lion, but the donkey and corpse were unharmed
 - h. The old prophet buried the younger one in his own tomb, as a lesson in faithfulness
- B. When we are consciously weak, then we can handle His anointing -2^{nd} Cor. 12:9-10
 - 1. Be aware of your weaknesses (thorn), His strength is made perfect at that very point
 - 2. We learn to "boast" in infirmities, not brag, but we can trade them for His anointing!
